THE REPORT

Introduction

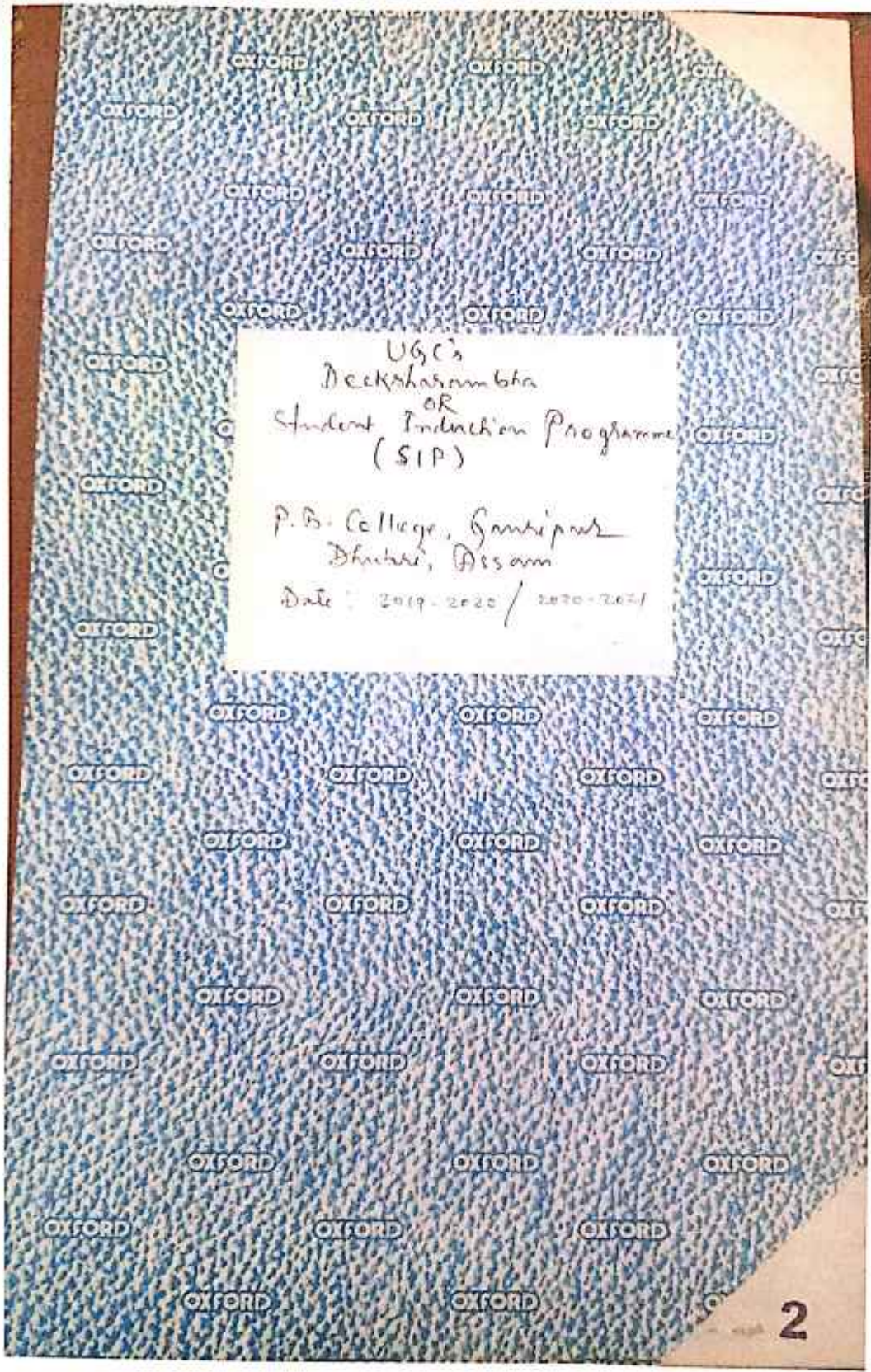
Conclusion

of the Induction Program in shaping students' understanding of their roles and responsibilities as members of the college community.



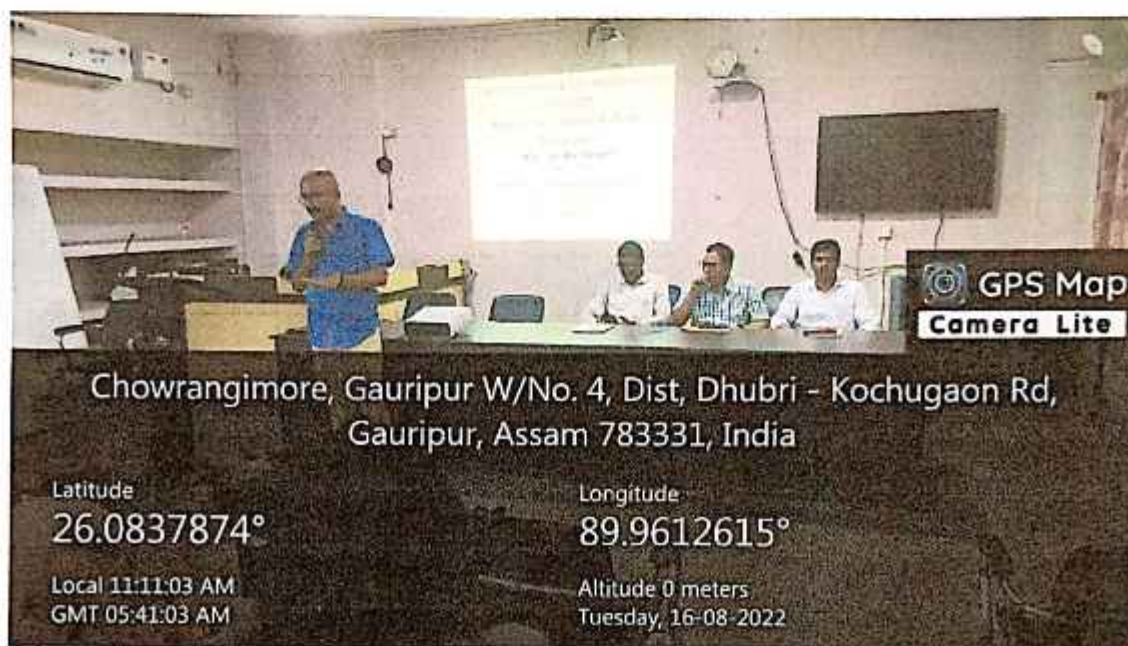
Session 2: Overview of College Policies and Facilities

cultural program was followed by informal interactions over refreshments, allowing students and faculty members to mingle and build rapport in a relaxed setting.



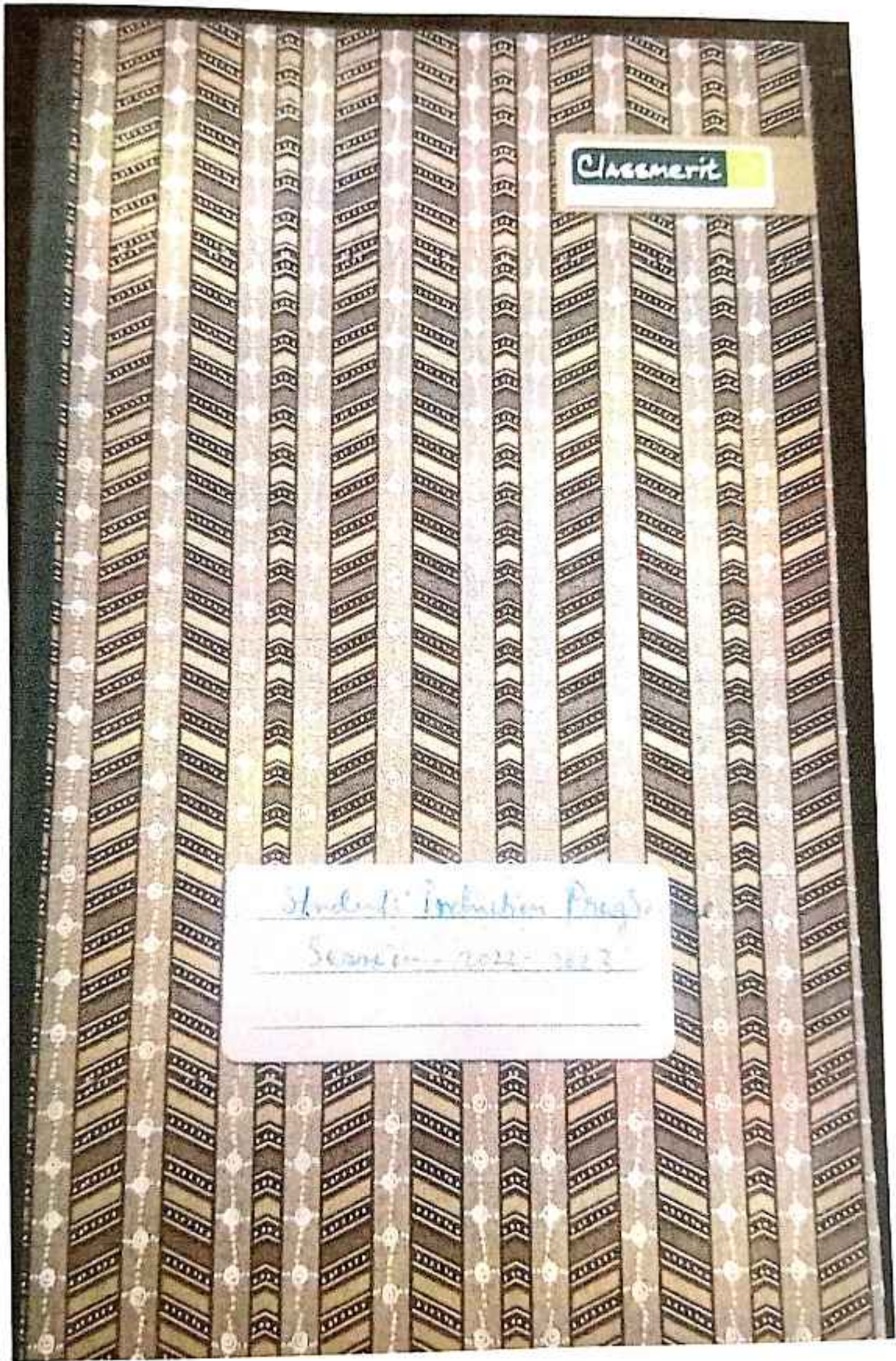
Conclusion
